California illustrator Erin Hunter launches her fall 2010 release this month

MOUNT PLEASANT, S.C. (Aug. 2, 2010) - Erin Hunter’s, “A Day on the Mountain,” hits bookshelves nationwide this month. To celebrate the new release, the Pacific Grove Museum of Natural History will host and co-sponsor a launch party on Saturday, Aug. 14 at 2 p.m.

Told in rhyming verse, *A Day on the Mountain* takes readers up a mountain, from the forested bottom to the snow-covered top. While climbing, they witness the changing habitats, and meet the plants and animals that live there. Hunter’s vibrant illustrations invite children to explore nature while learning about the diverse habitats and wildlife as they travel higher and higher up the mountain.
