## **Under the Sea, Slime is Goey Good!**

Mt. Pleasant, SC (February 1, 2014) – Kids aren't the only ones that like slime. Leading ocean expert Dr. Ellen Prager with illustrator Shennen Bersani introduce children to the many ways sea creatures use slime (aka mucus) in the ocean in their new underwater adventure, *Sea Slime: It's Eeuwy, Goey, and Under the Sea*.

*Sea Slime* hits stores February 10<sup>th</sup> with full-color spreads introducing young children to creatures large and small that use slime to protect themselves, to move from place to place, or to catch food. Prager takes her wealth of knowledge about marine life to excite children about the science behind ocean slime. The text is enhanced by Bersani's detailed and realistic illustrations.

As with all Sylvan Dell Publishing books *Sea Slime* includes a For Creative Minds section filled with fun facts and activities to dive deeper into the sea life found within the pages of the story. Her art delivers a unique blend of realism, heartfelt emotion, love of nature, and life lessons for children of all ages. In addition to *Sea Slime: It's Eeuwy, Goocy and Under the Sea*; *The Shape Family Babies*; *Shark Baby*; *Home in the Cave*; *The Glaciers are Melting!*, and *Astro: The Steller Sea Lion* for Sylvan Dell, Shennen has illustrated a number of best-selling books, including, *Snakes: Long, Longer, Longest*; *Sharks: Big, Bigger, Biggest*; *Ocean Counting: Odd Numbers*; *Icky Bug Shapes*; and *My Sister, Alicia May*.
